Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the approval and regulation of schools of barbering and schools of hairdressing and beauty culture were repealed by Public Law 1983, chapter 140; and

Whereas, there are no comprehensive statutes or regulations in place to govern the operation of these schools; and
