20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §2251, sub-§6, as enacted by PL
23 1971, c. 601, §2, is amended to read:

24 6. Medical training; veterans. Has successfully
25 completed the training requirements of an organized
26 military medical assistant course which meets crite-
27 ria established by the board and has had at least
28 2-years' experience under nursing supervision; or

29 Sec. 2. 32 MRSA §2251, sub-§7 is enacted to
30 read:

31 7. Experience. Has at least 3-years' experience
32 in practical nursing as determined under criteria es-
33 tablished by the board.

STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill permits a person with 3-years' practical experience to be considered eligible for testing and licensing as a licensed practical nurse.

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
