Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the subject areas become highly congested with foot and vehicular traffic during the summer season; and

Whereas, current facilities are not adequate to properly service the great influx of people during the summer season; and

Whereas, additional facilities on a year-round basis would create a needless expense; and
