collected from ratepayers as part of the cost of providing them with electricity. The cost of fuel is very substantial and is dependent upon both the price of the fuel and upon the efficiency of the generating plant that uses that fuel. Currently, the commission does not generally determine whether a generating plant is using fuel efficiently and does not make a thorough determination as to whether the fuel cost is reasonable. If reasonable performance standards were instituted, then the commission and the utilities would be able to judge whether or not the plant was operating in a sound manner and whether the costs of providing electricity were reasonable.

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
