SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 752, L.D. 2055,

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Bill, "AN ACT To Amend the Liquor Laws to Permit the

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Sale of Beer and Wine at Outdoor Stadiums."

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Amend the bill in section 13 in that part design-

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nated "§808." by striking out all of subsection 3

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(page 5, lines 11 to 14 in L.D.) and inserting in its

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place the following:

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'3. Conditions on sales. A separate area shall

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be set aside for the sale and consumption of liquor

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at an outdoor stadium. No liquor may be sold or con-

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sumed in the spectator stands at an outdoor stadium.

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Liquor may be sold only by the glass in plastic or

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paper cups.'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this amendment is to provide that

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liquor may only be sold and consumed in separate ar-


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reas at outdoor stadiums.
