COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1556,
L.D. 2057, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Conveyance of
Rolled Bales of Hay."

Amend the bill in that part designated "§1701."
in the 2nd line from the end (page 2, line 30 in
L.D.) by striking out the underlined words "or rolled
baled"

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end
before the statement of fact the following:

'Rolled baled hay may be loaded on vehicles not
to exceed 11 feet in width when transported on vehi-
cles within a 20-mile radius of the farm on which the
hay is harvested or to be stored. Vehicles used for
the transportation of rolled baled hay, in accordance
with this section, shall not be operated on any pub-
lic way during the period from 1/2 hour after sunset
to 1/2 hour before sunrise.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment restricts loads of rolled baled
hay to 11 feet in width and permits vehicles trans-
porting overwide loads of baled hay to operate in a
20-mile radius of the farm on which the hay is har-
vested or to be stored. Overwide loads of baled hay
may not be transported on public ways during hours of
darkness.
