HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1561, L.D. 2063,
Bill, "AN ACT Concerning Tax Exempt Status of Prop-
erty owned by the Farmington Village Corporation."

Amend the bill by inserting before the enacting
clause the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis-
lature do not become effective until 90 days after
adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, April 1, 1984, is the date prior to
which the property tax assessment must be made on
property owned by the Farmington Village Corporation;
and

Whereas, the 90-day period may not expire until
after that date; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,
these facts create an emergency within the meaning of
the Constitution of Maine and require the following
legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-
vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
therefore, '

Further amend the bill by inserting before the
Statement of Fact the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency
cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect
when approved.'
