AN ACT Concerning Tax Exempt Status of
Property owned by the Farmington Village
Corporation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

P&SL 1959, c. 90, Sec. 2-C is amended to read:

Sec. 2-C. Property tax exempt. The property of said corporation shall be exempt from taxation by ~~any town~~ the Town of Farmington.
