HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1562, L.D. 2064,
Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Charter of the Van Buren
Light and Power District."

10 Amend the bill by striking out all of the amend-11 ing clause (page 2, lines 9 to 11 in L.D.) and in-12 serting in its place the following:

13 'Sec. 1. P&SL 1917, c. 182, §6, first sentence, 14 as repealed and replaced by P&SL 1979, c. 38, §6, is 15 amended to read:'

16 Further amend the bill by inserting before the 17 emergency clause the following:

18 'Sec. 2. P&SL 1917, c. 182, §9, sub-§2, as enacted by P&SL 1979, c. 38, is amended to read:

20 2. Sinking fund, serial debt. To provide each 21 and every year after April 1, 1920, a sum equal to 22 not less than 1/2%, nor more than 3%, and after April 23 1, 1925, a sum of not less than 1% nor more than 5% 24 of the entire term indebtedness of the Van Buren 25 Light and Power District, which sum shall be set aside as a sinking fund to provide for the final ex-26 27 tinguishment of the funded debt. The money set aside for the sinking fund shall be devoted to the retire-28 29 ment of the long term and short term obligations of 30 the district or invested in such securities as sav-31 ings banks are allowed to hold. In addition to the establishment of a sinking fund, the board of trust-32 33 ees may issue long-term bonds or notes payable in 34 such annual installments as the board, subject to the approval of the Public Utilities Commission, may de-35 termine and, in that event, the rates shall provide 36 37 for the payment in each year of the annual

1 installments of principal due in each such year; and'

STATEMENT OF FACT

6132030784

The purpose of this amendment is to allow the district to issue serial bonds. That financing procedure has become common since the district charter was first written. This has immediate importance because the application of the district to borrow \$200,000 from the Maine Municipal Bond Bank has been approved.
