22 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts of the Legis-
23 lature do not become effective until 90 days after
24 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

25 Whereas, on Tuesday, February 7, 1984, the Maine
26 Secondary School Principals' Association rejected a
27 student's appeal to waive section 2-E of the associa-
28 tion's eligibility rules; and

29 Whereas, without this waiver, the student, who is
30 otherwise eligible and who has completed the entire
31 regular season, will be arbitrarily and capriciously
32 denied the opportunity to participate in post-season
33 play after reaching 20 years of age on February 23,
34 1984; and
