20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
21 follows:

22 17-A MRSA §807 is enacted to read:

23 §807. Vandalism

24 1. A person is guilty of vandalism if, inten-  
25 tionally or knowingly, he:

26 A. Damages, destroys, defaces, mars or injures  
27 any of the following, or the grounds adjacent to  
28 or owned or leased by any of the following:

29 (1) A church;

30 (2) A synagogue;
