Amend the bill in section 4 in that part design-
ated "§1001" by striking out all of subsection 4 and
inserting in its place the following:

'4. Preparation of arguments against. Arguments
against the ballot question shall be drafted by a
committee of 6 persons, all of whom shall be persons
known to oppose the measure. One person shall be ap-
pointed to the committee by each of the following:
The President of the Senate, the Speaker of the House
of Representatives, the Senate Majority Leader, the
Senate Minority Leader, the House Majority Leader and
the House Minority Leader.'
