 The Legislature directs the Public Utilities Commission to take all necessary action, including, but not limited to, a targeted subsidy to a segment of residential customers to the extent deemed necessary and reasonable by the commission to ensure that affordable and universally available telephone service within the State continues to exist.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill recognizes the importance of universal telephone service to Maine people and instructs the Public Utilities Commission to take all appropriate actions to ensure the continued availability of universal telephone service for Maine people.
