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HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1589, L.D. 2099,  
Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Statutes Relating to Hand-  
icapping Conditions Under the Human Services Law."

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Amend the Bill in section 2 in that part design-  
ated "§1531." in the 10th, 11th and 12th lines (page  
2, lines 5 to 7 in L.D.) by striking out the under-  
lined words "legally qualified practitioner of medi-  
cine of the town in which the parents of the infant  
reside" and inserting in their place the following:  
'physician licensed under Title 32, chapter 36 or 48'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The amendment removes the requirement that a re-  
port be made to a physician in the town where the  
parents reside and clarifies that it may be made to  
either an allopathic or osteopathic physician.
