AN ACT to Amend the Charter of the  
Kingfield Water Company to Increase the Number  
of Trustees from 3 to 5.

---

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the annual district meeting of the Kingfield Water District is held in March; and

Whereas, this legislation must be enacted as an emergency in order to take effect before the annual water district meeting; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
2 follows:

3 P&SL 1951, c. 103, §6, 6th sentence is repealed  
4 and the following enacted in its place:

5 At the annual meeting in 1984, 2 additional trustees  
6 shall be elected, one elected for a term of 2 years  
7 and one for a term of 3 years. Thereafter, each  
8 trustee shall be elected for a term of 3 years. At  
9 each annual meeting of the district, the voters  
10 therein shall elect a number of trustees, equal to  
11 the number of trustees currently on the board whose  
12 terms of office are expiring, to hold office for 3  
13 years.

14 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited  
15 in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when ap-  
16 proved.

17 STATEMENT OF FACT

18 The purpose of this bill is to increase the num-  
19 ber of trustees for the Kingfield Water District from  
20 3 to 5.
