"section," the following: 'until July 1, 1989.'

10 of amendment) by striking out the word "Amend" and

1 4-A. Wineries. Beginning on July 1, 1989, win-
2 eries using exclusively the agricultural products of
3 this State as raw material shall pay an annual li-
4 cence fee of.....\$50.

5 Wineries using in part the agricultural products of
6 other states or foreign countries shall pay, in addi-
7 tion to the license fee of \$50, an excise tax of 4¢
8 per gallon, or its metric equivalent, on liquid raw
9 materials and 2¢ per pound on solid or semisolid raw
10 materials; the same being under the supervision of
11 the commission, which shall make the necessary rules
12 and regulations for their collection.'

14 The purpose of this amendment is to clarify the
15 sunset provision.
