14 15 This amendment changes the waiting period between filing of intentions to marry and issuance of a marriage license from 5 days to 3 days. The original bill had shortened the period to only one day. The original bill proposed permitting Superior Court justices, as well as District Court judges and Probate Court judges, to waive the waiting period. This amendment also proposes allowing Supreme Judicial Court justices to waive the waiting period.
