22 23 24	Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis- lature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
25 26 27	Whereas, certain unorganized territories have developed clam conservation ordinances that require prompt approval; and
28 29 30	Whereas, the existing requirement for approval at referendum is unclear and may require unnecessary expense; and
31 32 33 34	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-

1 2	vation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,
3 4	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
5 6 7	12 MRSA §6671, sub-§6, ¶C, as enacted by PL 1983, c. 283, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

An unorganized territory in which at least 10 residents have petitioned the county commissioners to adopt a clam conservation ordinance and in which the county commissioners have held a public hearing with at least 7 days prior notice. The hearing shall be held in the unorganized township. The county commissioners shall act as the municipal legislative body within an unorganized township that has petitioned to adopt ordinances under this section.
18 19 20	Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.
21	STATEMENT OF FACT
22 23 24 25	The purpose of this bill is to clarify the procedural requirements for the adoption of clam conservation ordinances in the unorganized territories and to avoid any potentially unnecessary expenses.
