RESOLVE, Authorizing the Bureau of Public Lands to Convey the State's Title to Certain Land in Grand Falls to the Grand Falls Historical Society.

---

Director of Bureau of Public Lands to convey interest in lot. Resolved: That the Director of Bureau of Public Lands, Department of Conservation, is authorized to grant to the Grand Falls Historical Society of Grand Falls by quitclaim deed for \$1 all right, title and interest of the State in:

"A certain parcel of land and buildings thereon, in Grand Falls Plantation, Penobscot County, Maine bounded as follows: Beginning at a point on the Bryant Ridge Road 20 feet north of the school house, thence easterly 40 feet; thence southerly to the Harvey Stickney Road, thence westerly on said road to the Bryant Ridge Road; thence northerly along said road to point of starting. Being part of Lot No. ---

1 Range --- and containing 1/2 acre more or less being  
2 same lot on which the school house now stands."

3 STATEMENT OF FACT

4 This resolve transfers the state's interest in a  
5 certain school lot in Grand Falls, Penobscot County  
6 to the the Grand Falls Historical Society. This par-  
7 cel of land was municipally owned by Grand Falls  
8 Plantation until its deorganization on March 31,  
9 1981, when its care, custody and control was dele-  
10 gated to the Bureau of Public Lands.
