SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1625, L.D. 2142,
Bill, "AN ACT Concerning the Open Burning of Leaves
and Brush."

Amend the bill by inserting after the enacting
clause the following:

'Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §582, sub-§8, as enacted by PL
1969, c. 474, §1, is amended to read;

8. Municipality. "Municipality" includes, for
purposes of enacting an air pollution control ordi-
nance, only cities and, organized towns and
plantations.'

Further amend the bill in section 1, in paragraph
F, in the 8th line (page 1, line 33 in L.D.) by
striking out the underlined words "a plantation or"

Further amend the bill by renumbering the sec-
tions to read consecutively.

This amendment extends to plantations the same
air pollution ordinance power as cities and towns.
