COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1656,
L.D. 2186, Bill, "AN ACT to Establish Farm Programs
at Correctional Facilities."

Amend the bill in subsection 7, in paragraph A,
by striking out all of the 2nd underlined sentence
(page 1, lines 30 to 32 in L.D.) and inserting in its
place the following:

'If a surplus exists, it may be:

(1) Sold or distributed to other state,
county or local governmental entities;

(2) Exchanged with other state, county or
local governmental entities for services or
other goods; or

(3) Sold to or exchanged with private Maine
businesses.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The amendment expands the options open to the fa-
cilities in handling surplus produce from the farm
program to include exchange with other governmental
entities, or sale to or exchange with Maine busi-
nesses. In undertaking any of these options, it is
not the Legislature's intent to cause an adverse im-
pact on any Maine business or organization.
