Amend the Bill in section 1, subsection 7, by striking out all of paragraphs C and D (page 2, lines 11 12 13 3 to 18 in L.D.) and inserting in their place the 14 following: 'C. Office building or space of less than 5,000 15 16 square feet and, at the time of application, as 17 determined according to rules adopted by the au-18 thority: 19 (1) Less than 20% of the employees in the 20 existing office building represent new jobs 21 over a 3-year period immediately prior to the time of application; 22 23 (2) Less than 20% of the employees who oc-24 cupy the new office building represent new 25 jobs within the first year following occupa-26 tion of the new office building; or 27 That the increase in the number of new (3) jobs in the municipality represented by the 28 occupants in the proposed office building is 29 30 not expected to be a significant increase. 31 as determined by the authority, and would 32 not make an important contribution to the 33 economy of the municipality for which the 34 project is proposed. 35 Further amend the Bill in section 1, subsection

STATEMENT OF FACT 2 The purpose of this amendment is to establish a uniform standard for all municipalities with respect 3 4 5 to eligibility criteria for new office building con-6 struction financed through revenue obligation bond 7 financing. This amendment: 8 1. Establishes a minimum of 5,000 square feet for an eligible office building construction project 9 for all municipalities in the State; 10 11 2. Removes the population differential in the 12 current bill; and 13 3. Requires that: A. A minimum of 20% of the employees occupying 14 15 the existing office building represent new jobs 16 over a 3-year period immediately prior to the ap-17 plication; B. A minimum of 20% of the employees occupying 18 the new office building represent new jobs within 19 20 the first year of occupation of the new building; 21 or 22 C.
