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SENATE AMENDMENT " A" to HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to  
H.P. 1665, L.D. 2197, Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify the  
Licensing Authority of the Board of Registration in

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Amend the amendment in the last paragraph , last  
line before the statement of fact (page 1 line 31 in  
amendment) by inserting after the underlined word  
"Boards" the following: 'or such examinations desig-  
nated by the board as the qualifying examination or  
examinations for licensure. Each applicant shall ad-  
ditionally be required to achieve a passing score on  
a State of Maine examination administered by the  
board.'
