7 HOUSE AMENDMENT "h" to H.P. 1665, L.D. 2197, 8 Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify the Licensing Authority of 9 the Board of Registration in Medicine."

Amend the Bill in section 1 in that part designated "<u>§3271.</u>" in subsection 2, 2nd line (page 2, line 16 in L.D.) by inserting after the underlined word "<u>school</u>" the following: '<u>on or after January 1,</u> 14 1970'

15 Further amend the Bill in section 1 in that part designated "§3271." in subsection 2 by inserting af-16 17 ter the first sentence the following: 'Each applicant who has graduated from an accredited medical 18 school prior to January 1, 1970, is required to have 19 20 satisfactorily completed at least 12 months in a 21 graduate educational program approved by the Accreditation Council on Graduate Medical Education, the Ca-22 23 nadian Medical Association or the Royal College of 24 Physicians and Surgeons of Canada.

Further amend the Bill in section 1 in that part designated "§3271." by striking out all of subsection 3 (page 2, lines 29 to 36 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

29 '3. Examination. Each applicant shall receive a
 30 passing score on the uniform examination of the Fed 31 eration of State Medical Boards.'

32 STATEMENT OF FACT 33 The purpose of this amendment is to provide that 34 physicians graduating from accredited medical schools 35 prior to 1970 have to meet a 12-month postgraduate

requirement, as is the case under present law. "Unaccredited" in the bill means a school not accred-1 2 ited by the Liaison Committee on Medical Education. 3 4 Two-year postgraduate programs were not widely available prior to 1970, so the provision as originally 5 6 drafted would create hardship for physicians who com-7 pleted their medical education prior to that year. 8 The last section of the amendment corrects an error in the bill as it relates to the national examining 9 10 entity.
