HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1666, L.D. 2198,
Bill, "AN ACT Concerning Hazardous Materials Control."

Amend the Bill in section 2 in that part designated "§2102-A." in subsection 1 by inserting at the end the following: "Commerce" does not mean movement of hazardous materials by a farmer for his own use to and from the farm or field within a 20-mile radius."

Further amend the Bill in section 8 by striking out all of that part designated "2105-A." and inserting in its place the following:

'§2105-A. Enforcement

It is the responsibility of the State Police, sheriffs and their deputies and all other police officers to investigate any alleged violations of this chapter and any rules adopted by reference thereto. Prior to taking enforcement action, a law enforcement officer shall have met minimum training requirements established by the Criminal Justice Academy with respect to hazardous materials."
