7 HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 819, L.D. 2199,
8 Bill, "AN ACT to Require State Agencies Authorized to
9 Expend Proceeds of Bonds Approved by the Electorate
10 to Report the Status of the Bonds to the Legislature
11 Prior to the Date of Deauthorization as Provided in
12 the Constitution of Maine."

13 Amend the bill by inserting at the beginning of
14 the first line after the enacting clause the follow-
15 ing: 'Sec. 1.'

16 Further amend the bill in that part designated
17 "§524." in the 5th line (page 2, line 25 in L.D.) by
18 striking out the underlined word "may" and inserting
19 in its place the following: 'shall recommend that the
20 Legislature'

21 Further amend the bill by inserting at the end
22 before the statement of fact the following:

23 'Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act shall take
24 effect on December 15, 1984, only if, prior to Decem-
25 ber 15, 1984, the Secretary of State certifies to the
26 Governor that the Constitution of Maine has been
27 amended as ratified by the voters in the general
28 election of November 1984 to require the Legislature
29 to authorize, by majority vote, the issue of autho-
30 rized but unissued bonds for projects for which there
31 has been a partial issue of bonds.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

2 The purpose of this amendment is to provide that
3 the provisions of this bill will take effect only in
4 the event that the Constitutional Resolution in Leg-
5 islative Document 1832, "RESOLUTION, Proposing an
6 Amendment to the Constitution of Maine to Limit the
7 Life of Authorized Bonds," is ratified by the voters
8 in the general election of November 1984.
