IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD
NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FOUR

AN ACT Relating to Funding of Stoneham
Schools for 1984-85.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the property of Evergreen Valley in the Town of Stoneham has become state property and exempt from property tax; and

Whereas, this change of status will not be accounted for in state valuation for 2 years; and

Whereas, school funding is based upon state valuation and Stoneham needs additional funding before the change of status is accounted for through state valuation; and

1 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,
2 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of
3 the Constitution of Maine and require the following
4 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-
5 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
6 therefore,

7 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
8 follows:

9 Appropriation. The following funds are appropri-
10 ated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes
11 of this Act.

\$3,856.50

18 These funds are to be paid to
19 the Town of Stoneham to assist
20 the town in paying their educa-
21 tional assessment in the 1984-85
22 fiscal year only.

23 Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited
24 in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when ap-
25 proved.
