19 Andover North Surplus Township as
20 Gradys Mountain.

22 Designation of Gradys Mountain. Resolved: That
23 a certain unnamed mountain, with an elevation of
24 2,640', located in the north easterly part of Andover
25 North Surplus, bounded on the north by the north line
26 of Andover North Surplus; on the east by the Appala-
27 chian Trail; on the south east by Surplus Pond; on
28 the south by an unnamed mountain, the West Branch of
29 the Ellis River and the highway from Andover to Route
30 26; and on the west by Spruce Mountain, so called, be
31 designated as "Gradys Mountain."

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this resolve is to designate an unnamed mountain in Andover North Surplus, Gradys Mountain, in honor of the Grady family who are the only people who inhabit the area near the base.

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
