gency preamble.

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Further amend the bill by striking out all of the  
emergency clause.

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
STATEMENT OF FACT

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This amendment removes the emergency preamble and  
the emergency clause from the bill. As amended, the  
purpose of this bill is to allow commission members  
to be reimbursed for travel expenses to hearings held  
before March 30, 1984, to allow the hearings to be  
held in communities near to the risk area and to  
change the deadline for completion of the commission-  
er's report from the end of the Second Regular Ses-  
sion of the 111th Legislature to the beginning of the  
First Regular Session of the 112th Legislature.
