17 AN ACT Relating to Itemized Telephone

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 35 MRSA §2702 is enacted to read:

23 §2702. Itemized bills

24 Every telephone company operating in this State
25 shall provide each customer, at the end of each bill-
26 ing period, with an itemized list of long distance
27 calls, both interstate and intrastate, including the
28 date, number called, duration of the call and the pe-
29 riod when the call was made.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The telephone companies have discontinued their practice of providing itemized bills for some long distance calls. This bill requires continued itemization.

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
