**RESOLVE, Reimbursing Jeffrey Bellmore of
Waldoboro for Damages Caused by the Actions of
a State Ward.**

Jeffrey Bellmore reimbursed. Resolved: That,
notwithstanding any provision of law, there is appropriated from the General Fund \$2,500 to be paid to Jeffrey Bellmore, of Waldoboro, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for damage caused to a motor vehicle owned by him which was damaged on or about November 26, 1983, while being operated by a minor who was a ward of the State.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this resolve is to reimburse Jeffrey Bellmore of Waldoboro for damages caused to his motor vehicle which was involved in an accident while being operated by a state ward on November 26, 1983.

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
