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19 AN ACT Concerning the Issuance of Bonds  
20 by Lincoln County.

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22 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts of the Legis-  
23 lature do not become effective until 90 days after  
24 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

25 Whereas, this legislation is vitally necessary to  
26 avoid the undue burden of temporary financing; and

27 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,  
28 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of  
29 the Constitution of Maine and require the following  
30 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-  
31 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,  
32 therefore,

33 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
34 follows:

1 P&SL 1983, c. 20, §3, 2nd sentence is amended to  
2 read:

3 Each authorized issue shall be payable in such annual  
4 installments, beginning not more than 2 years from  
5 the date thereof and not earlier than the year ~~1986~~  
6 1985, as will extinguish each loan in not more than  
7 20 years from its date.

8 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited  
9 in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when ap-  
10 proved.

11 STATEMENT OF FACT

12 The purpose of this bill is to realize a savings  
13 for Lincoln County in the issuance of  
14 self-liquidating bonds authorized by Private and Spe-  
15 cial Law 1983, chapter 20.

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
