10 11	Amend the bill by striking out all of the emergency preamble.
12 13 14	Further amend the bill in section 2 by striking out all of subsection 1-D (page 4, lines 8 to 11 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:
15 16 17 18	'1-D. Municipal solid waste. "Municipal solid waste" means solid waste emanating from domestic and commercial sources within the State over which municipalities are authorized to exercise control.
19 20 21 22	Further amend the bill in section 3 in that part designated "§2326" by striking out all of the 3rd sentence (page 5, lines 15 to 21 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:
23 24 25 26 27 28 29	'In the event competing petitions are filed by small power producers or cogenerators which are otherwise equivalent with respect to the standards set forth in section 2327, and implementing rules promulgated by the commission, the commission may give preference to any such facility that is fueled primarily by municipal solid waste.'
30 31	Further amend the bill by striking out all of the emergency clause.
32	STATEMENT OF FACT
33	The purpose of this amendment is to strike the

- emergency preamble and the emergency clause. The amendment also gives the Public Utilities Commission
- 3 discretionary authority to grant preference to municipalities over nonmunicipal developers in competing
- 5 applications which are otherwise the same.
