HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to S.P. 835, L.D. 2236,
Bill, "AN ACT to Increase the Minimum Wage to \$3.55."

Amend the bill by striking out all of the title
and inserting in its place the following:

'AN ACT to Increase the Minimum Wage over a 3-year
period to \$3.65.'

Further amend the bill in the 9th line after the
enacting clause (page 1, line 31 in L.D.) by striking
out the following: "\$3.55 per hour" and inserting in
its place the following: "\$3.45 per hour starting on
January 1, 1985, and \$3.55 per hour starting on Janu-
ary 1, 1986, and \$3.65 per hour starting on January
1, 1987'"

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this amendment is to provide a 30¢
increase in the minimum wage to be phased in over a
3-year period.
