12	'1. Establishment and membership. There is es-
13	tablished within the Department of Business, Occupa-
14	tional and Professional Regulation, a Board of Occu-
15	pational Therapy Practice. The board shall consist of
16	5 members appointed by the Governor. The persons ap-
17	pointed to the board, other than the public member,
18	must have been engaged in rendering occupational
19	therapy services to the public, teaching or research
20	in occupational therapy for at least 2 years immedi-
21	ately preceding their appointments. At least 3 board
22	members shall be occupational therapists. The 4th
23	member shall be either an occupational therapist or
24	an occupational therapy assistant, if available.
25	These members shall at all times be holders of valid
26 27	licenses for the practice of occupational therapy in
28	the State, except for the members of the first board, all of whom shall fulfill the requirements for licen-
29	sure of this chapter. The remaining member shall be a
30	representative of the public.

34	Further amend the Bill in section 2 in that part
