On or after September 1, 1984 January 1, 1985, it shall be unlawful for a dentist to allow a person to practice dental radiography in his employment or under his supervision who does not hold a license to practice dental radiography issued by the board or who is otherwise authorized by law to practice dental radiography.'
22 23	Further amend the Bill by renumbering section $\ 2$ to be section $\ 3$.
24	STATEMENT OF FACT
25 26 27 28 29	This amendment changes the effective date of another section of the license law to correspond to the change in section 1 of the bill. The section addressed by this amendment prohibits the employment of unlicensed dental radiographers by dentists.
