COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1691,
L.D. 2246, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Licensing of
Dental Radiographers."

Amend the Bill by inserting after section 1 the
following:

'Sec. 2. 32 MRSA §1100-L, as enacted by PL 1983,
c. 331, §2, is amended to read:

§1100-L. Employment of dental radiographers

1. Dental radiographers; license. On or after
~~September 1, 1984~~ January 1, 1985, it shall be unlaw-
ful for a dentist to allow a person to practice den-
tal radiography in his employment or under his super-
vision who does not hold a license to practice dental
radiography issued by the board or who is otherwise
authorized by law to practice dental radiography.'

Further amend the Bill by renumbering section 2
to be section 3.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment changes the effective date of an-
other section of the license law to correspond to the
change in section 1 of the bill. The section ad-
dressed by this amendment prohibits the employment of
unlicensed dental radiographers by dentists.
