11	'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis-
12	lature do not become effective until 90 days after
13	adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
14 15	Whereas, the stocks of striped bass are declining rapidly and are in imminent danger of depletion; and
16	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,
17	these facts create an emergency within the meaning of
18	the Constitution of Maine and require the following
19	legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-
20	vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
21	therefore,'
22	Further amend the bill by inserting at the begin-
23	ning of the first line after the enacting clause
24	(page 1, line 22 in L.D.) the following: 'Sec. 1. '
25	Further amend the bill by adding at the end be-
26	fore the statement of fact the following:
27 28	'Sec. 2. Sunset. This section is repealed on December 31, 1987.
29	Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited
30	in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when ap-
31	proved.'
