the underlined punctuation and words ", furnishing or
giving away"

The amendment retains the provision that ciga-
rettes may be sold to children under 18, with paren-
tal permission, but removes the ability of correc-
tional facilities officers and sheriffs to allow the
furnishing or giving away of cigarettes.
