This amendment corrects a citation to the education laws to clarify that schools shall release information regarding students when necessary to comply
with the requirement of the Child and Family Services
and Child Protection Act. The original bill
inadvertantly omitted the citation to the Revised
Statutes, Title 20-A, section 6001, which addresses
dissemination of information about students held by
schools.

This amendment also removes references to the Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation records from the bill. The original bill added Bureau of Mental Health and Mental Retardation records to the list of records which confidential quality is abrogated for purposes of complying with the Act.
