COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 839,
L.D. 2263, Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify the Disciplinary
Procedure of the Nurse Practice Laws."

Amend the bill in section 2, subsection 3 by
striking out the last paragraph (page 3, lines 31 to
33 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'A copy of any report, information or record received
by the board under this subsection shall be provided
to the licensee.'

Further amend the bill in section 3, in that part
designated "§2108-A." by striking out all of subsec-
tion 1 and renumbering subsections 2 and 3 to be sub-
sections 1 and 2.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The first part of this amendment provides that
the licensee under investigation shall receive a copy
of all confidential materials submitted to the board
under the Revised Statutes, Title 32, section 2105-A,
subsection 3.

The 2nd part of this amendment removes a provi-
sion in the bill granting immunity from liability for
persons who file complaints with the board. This
provision is not typically found in other licensing
laws and could encourage the filing of unfounded com-
plaints.
