Amend the bill by inserting after the Emergency  
clause the following:

'Preamble. Two thirds of both Houses of the Leg-  
islature deeming it necessary in accordance with the  
Constitution of Maine, Article IX, Section 14, to au-  
thorize the issuance of bonds on behalf of the State  
of Maine to provide for the design, construction and  
equipping of a crime lab and morgue.'

Further amend the bill in section 1, 5th line  
(page 2, line 13 in L.D.) by striking out the words  
"serial coupon" and inserting in their place the fol-  
lowing: 'registered'

(page 2, line 20 in L.D.) by striking out the figure  
"20" and inserting in its place the following: '5'

5 The total cost of this bill is estimated to be  
6 \$1,809,375. This amount includes interest calculated  
7 at 8.25% over 5 years.

8 STATEMENT OF FACT

9 The purpose of this amendment is to reduce the  
10 life of the bonds from 20 years to 5 years and to re-  
11 move any references to State Police.
