RESOLVE, for Laying of the County Taxes
and Authorizing Expenditures of Androscoggin
County for the Year 1984.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, Androscoggin County has certain expenses and liabilities which must be met as they become due; and

Whereas, it is necessary that the taxes for the year 1984 hereinafter mentioned be immediately assessed in order to provide the required revenue for the county; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of

1 the Constitution of Maine and require the following
2 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-
3 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
4 therefore, be it

5 Sec. 1. Androscoggin County; taxes appor-
6 tioned. Resolved: That the following is hereby
7 granted as a tax on Androscoggin County to be appor-
8 tioned, assessed, collected and applied to the pur-
9 poses of paying debts and necessary expenses of the
10 county as authorized herein, and for other purposes
11 of law, for the calendar year 1984:
