23 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts of the Legis-
24 lature do not become effective until 90 days after
25 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

26 Whereas, the level of demand for inspection ser-
27 vices under the Maine Potato Quality Control Program
28 far exceeded expectations; and

29 Whereas, supplemental funds are needed to main-
30 tain inspection services and to satisfy continued de-
31 mand for inspections; and

32 Whereas, quality control is an essential ingredi-
33 ent in increasing market acceptance for Maine pota-
34 toes and maintaining market share; and
