HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A"
to S.P. 857, L.D. 2324, Bill, "AN ACT to Require an
Inventory, Permitting and Monitoring of Underground
Tanks Containing Gasoline, Oil and Toxic Materials."

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the
first and 2nd paragraphs after the Title and insert-
ing in their place the following:

'Amend the bill in section 1 by striking out all
of the first paragraph (page 2, lines 3 to 13 in
L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. Findings and purpose. The Legislature
finds that significant quantities of flammable, com-
bustible and toxic materials are currently being
stored in underground storage facilities and that nu-
merous incidents involving leaks or unlicensed dis-
charges from that underground storage are occurring
at a rate so as to pose a significant threat to
Maine's ground water resources.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this amendment is to correct an
inadvertent omission in the committee report.
