11 12 13	Amend the amendment by striking out all of the first and 2nd paragraphs after the title and insert- ing in their place the following:
14	'Amend the bill in section 1 by striking out all
15	of the first paragraph (page 2, lines 3 to 13 in
16	L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:
17	'Sec. 1. Findings and purpose. The Legislature
18	finds that significant quantities of flammable, com-
19	bustible and toxic materials are currently being
20	stored in underground storage facilities and that nu-
21	merous incidents involving leaks or unlicensed dis-
22	charges from that underground storage are occurring
23	at a rate so as to pose a significant threat to
24	Maine's ground water resources.'
25	Further amend the amendment by striking out in
26	the 14th paragraph after the title, the first 3 lines
27	(page 3, lines 2 to 4 in amendment) and inserting in
28	their place the following:
29	'Sec. 14. 38 MRSA §1306-C, sub-§4, ¶B, as en-
30	acted by PL 1981, c. 430, §18, is amended to read:
31	B. The proceeds of a sale shall be used to pay
32	the costs of cleanup, abatement or mitigation of
33	any threats or hazards to public health or safety
34	or to the environment, the costs of any removal,
35	storage, treatment, disposal or other handling of
36	hazardous waste or hazardous substances, as de-
37	fined in section 1362, reasonable expenses for

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1 the forfeiture proceedings, seizure, storage, 2 maintenance of custody, advertising and notice, 3 and to pay any bona fide mortgage thereon, and 4 the balance, if any, shall be deposited in the 5 General Fund.

6 Sec. 15. Allocation. The following funds are 7 allocated from the Maine Coastal Protection Fund for 8 the purposes of this Act.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

10 The purpose of this amendment is to correct an 11 inadvertent omission in the committee report.

12 This amendment also corrects an oversight in leg-13 islation which was enacted last session. It allows 14 the State to apply the proceeds from forfeited prop-15 erty to the cleanup of the environmental damage.
