7 HOUSE AMENDMENT "/4" to H.P. 1761, L.D. 2325, 8 Bill, "AN ACT to Prohibit any Type of Gambling Ma-9 chine."

10 Amend the Bill in section 1 in subsection 1-A by 11 striking out all of the first underlined sentence and inserting in its place the following: '"Electronic video machine" means a machine, however operated, 12 13 which has a video screen featuring an electronically 14 15 simulated game or games and delivers or entitles the person playing or operating it to receive the privi-lege of playing the electronic video machine without 16 17 charge, but does not deliver or entitle the person 18 19 playing or operating the electronic video machine to receive any cash, premiums, merchandise, tickets or something of value other than the privilege of play-20 21 22 ing the electronic video machine without charge.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment changes the definition of electronic video machine to make it clear that the statutes do not regulate machines with video screens featuring electronically simulated games that are played HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1761, L.D. 2325

purely for the amusement of playing the game and do not deliver or entitle the person playing or operating it to receive free replays or any cash, premiums, merchandise, tickets or something of value other than the free replay privilege.
