AN ACT to Limit the Increase in Secondary
School Tuition Rates.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 20-A MRSa §5805, sub-§2, as enacted by PL 1981, c. 693, §§5 and 8, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

2. Maximum allowable tuition. The maximum allowable tuition charge by a public secondary school shall be the lowest of:

A. The rate computed under subsection 1;

B. The state average per public secondary student cost as adjusted; or

C. One hundred ten percent of the allowable tuition charge of the previous year.
