16 17	Whereas, primary and general elections will be held this year; and
18 19 20	Whereas, by May 1st in the year of a general election, municipal officers must select ballot clerks; and
21 22 23 24	Whereas, if this Act is not enacted as an emergency, there will be insufficient time to establish a voting place in those unorganized townships which wish to do so; and
25 26 27 28 29 30	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'
31 32 33 34 35	Further amend the bill in section 2, in that part designated "§1573." in subsection 1, paragraph B, in the 4th line (page 2, line 18 in L.D.) by striking out the underlined figure " 4 " and inserting in its place the underlined figure ' 2 .

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:
'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'
6 STATEMENT OF FACT
The purpose of this amendment is to add an emer- gency preamble and emergency clause so that the pro- visions of the bill may take effect in time for this year's elections and to correct the number of ballot clerks which are required to be appointed. Cities and towns are required to have only 2 ballot clerks, although they may have more. Unorganized townships should also be required to have only 2.
