HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to HOUSE AMENDMENT "H" to
H.P. 1769, L.D. 2336, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning the
Funding of the Department of Inland Fisheries and
Wildlife."

Amend the amendment by striking out everything
after the Title and inserting in its place the fol-
lowing:

'Amend the bill by striking out all of Part L.

Further amend the bill by striking out all of
Part Q.

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end
before the emergency clause the following:

'PART R

Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7002 is enacted to read:

§7002. Use of funds received by department

Notwithstanding any other provision of this Part,
all funds received by the department under this Part
shall be deposited to the General Fund.

The Legislature shall annually appropriate from
the General Fund to the department an amount at least
equal to the revenues received from licenses and per-
mits under this Part and other revenues generated by
activities of the department.

Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §7074, sub-§3, as amended by PL
1979, c. 679, §2, is repealed.

Sec. 3. 12 MRSA §7074, sub-§4, as enacted by PL

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to HOUSE AMENDMENT "H" to H.P. 1769, L.D. 2336

1 1979, c. 420, §1, is repealed.

2 Sec. 4. 12 MRSA §7463-A, sub-§8, as enacted by
3 PL 1981, c. 118, §2, is repealed.'

4 Further amend the bill by striking out all of the
5 emergency clause and inserting in its place the fol-
6 lowing:

7 'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency
8 cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect
9 when approved, except for Part R which shall take ef-
10 fect on July 1, 1985.'

11 Further amend the bill by renumbering the Parts
12 to read consecutively.'

13 STATEMENT OF FACT

14 This amendment undedicates the Inland Fisheries
15 and Wildlife Fund, deletes the section requiring the
16 purchase of a migratory waterfowl permit and deletes
17 the fee increases in Part Q.
